Eligibility requirements:

Must be a senior graduating from Hudson High School.

Must have participated in a minimum of one YAH program or event.

Must attend a 2 or 4 year post-secondary school and successfully complete first semester.

Two Letters of Recommendation from adults are required. One letter must be from another organization/club where you have volunteered. Letters of Recommendation are not to be written by Youth Action Hudson employees, YAH current board members, or relatives.

**Scholarship Funds will be paid directly to college or tech school at end of first semester, upon receipt of official transcript submitted to YAH by youth recipient.** Any funds not distributed within two years after first semester will be returned to YAH Scholarship Fund.
